- must have a combination of secondary and tertiary level teaching experience
- must have taught Filipino in either or both the secondary and tertiary levels
- must have the capability to teach a variety of Language Education courses

ITEM 2

- with undergraduate academic preparation in language or a field that trains one in language and communication
- must have a doctoral degree OR at least a master's degree in Language Education (or a closely related field) from a reputable university
- must have a combination of secondary and tertiary level teaching experience
- must have taught English in either or both the secondary and tertiary levels
- must have the capability to teach a variety of Language Education courses
